Winter Storms Ma The

- Range
 - Moderate snow over a few hours
 - Blizzard conditions with blinding wind-driven snow that lasts for several days
- Many winter storms are accompanied by:
 - Low temperatures
 - Heavy or blowing snow, severely reducing visibility





Winter Storm Risks

- Automobile or other transportation accidents
- Exhaustion and heart attacks
- Hypothermia and frostbite
- House fires
- Asphyxiation

- Conserve fuel
- If outside, protect yourself from hazards

 - Winterize your vehicle
 - Keep charged cell phone or two-way radio with you at all times
 - Carry disaster supply kit in your vehicle
 - If stranded, stay inside your vehicle
